# Carine Morais HEAD JUDGE

The eight-time Salsa World
Champion and organizer of the
Brazil Latin Open, Carine Morais,
was born in Fortaleza, Ceará,
Brazil. Dancing has been part of
her life since childhood, when
she enjoyed pretending to be
a famous dancer. At the age of
five, she briefly studied ballet
but was unable to continue. By
thirteen, she had begun her
Brazilian dance studies, and

within a year, she was already teaching.

In 2003, while still very young, she traveled to Spain as part of a dance group's staff and participated in two seasons of a Brazilian music show. Her first contact with salsa took place in Ceará (Brazil) through a study group, where her first partner was Paulo Burracha. Thanks to her quality, adaptability, and dedication, Carine started attracting attention. Around 2006, she was invited to Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) to perform Brazilian dances such as samba de gafieira and funkeado, all while continuing her salsa studies and training.

In 2007, she won the Brazilian salsa championship (Brasil Salsa Open) alongside her partner, Paulo Burracha. In September 2008, she began her successful partnership with Rafael Barros, and together they have won eight world titles. Beyond becoming a leading figure in the dance world, Carine Morais and Rafael Barros have traveled to over 35 countries to teach and perform. She has also received numerous invitations to judge major dance championships around the globe and has made several appearances on television programs.



## **Elias Tabban**

Elías Tabbán is a professional salsa dancer, instructor, and choreographer with over 19 years of experience immersed in the world of Latin dance. He began his journey teaching children and adults, specializing in Cali-style salsa and Salsa On1, and quickly developed a reputation for shaping students into confident and versatile performers. Driven by

his commitment to excellence, Elías soon began competing on the international stage, establishing himself as both a formidable competitor and a sought-after coach.

His breakthrough came in 2011, when he won the Men Team category at the World Latin Dance Cup, followed by a victory in the Salsa On1 category in 2012. Beyond his personal achievements, Elías has guided multiple champions in various children's and youth categories, showcasing his remarkable ability to nurture talent. His dedication to fostering the next generation of dancers led him to co-found the SABA Championship Competition, a salsa and bachata event focused on elevating young performers.

Today, Elías continues to influence the global dance scene as a certified judge at the World Salsa Summit and as an organizer of prominent international competitions. Through his choreographies, he inspires dancers of all levels to strive for artistic growth and celebrate the vibrant culture of salsa.




## **Camila Brinez**

And it doesn't stop there he has also appear on shows such as MTV Super Sweet 16, BET Spring Bling, Premios Juventud and Premios Lu Nuestro.

His passion for dance has inspired others through his artistry of dance. And he is happy to pass on his knowledge and experience to the next generation of dancers as a sought after master teacher and judge.

Gabriela "Gaby" Puns is a dynamic force in the world of competitive dance, blending talent, leadership, and a deep passion for the art. She began her dance journey at just three years old at the prestigious Maria Verdeja School of Dance, where she built a strong foundation in technique and performance. By the age of eight, she entered the

competitive dance arena, earning top placements and multiple Platinum awards over the next six years—testament to her exceptional skill and dedication.

In high school, Gaby was a proud member of the legendary Coral Gables Gablettes, where she helped secure a coveted National Championship. This experience cemented her reputation as a disciplined, elite-level performer who thrived under the rigors of competition.

Today, Gaby is not only a seasoned dancer but also an influential educator and businesswoman. As the co-owner of Florida's only traditional dance academy (focused on preserving and promoting authentic dance styles), she fosters a supportive environment that nurtures growth and artistic excellence. Gaby remains dedicated to mentoring young dancers, sharing her love for movement, and elevating the dance community as a whole.



## **Melanie Castillo**

Melanie Castillo, born and raised in New York City, is a professional Latin Dancer. Having Puerto Rican and Dominican roots, she is no stranger to Latin music and dance. She started her dance training at the age of 5 and all roads led her to taking salsa classes once in college. She quickly realized that her passions lied within this dance since it was so close to home

with a strong connection to her roots and her culture.

Melanie has worked closely with salsa greats Nelson Flores (Descarga Latina), Sekou McMiller (Proyecto Descarga), and Ismael Otero (Caribbean Soul), as well as successful partnerships with Elvis Collado and Nina Tirado. Melanie is the creator, director, and choreographer of Candela Dance Company, which has gone to win two titles at the World Salsa Summit.

Her dance career has taken her around the world, visiting countries such as Mexico, China, Malaysia, Spain, South Africa, Sweden, and Canada, just to name a few. She was a principal dancer in the 2021 feature "In The Heights" and has worked on projects featuring Jose Alberto "El Canario", Víctor Manuelle, C + C Music Factory, La India, Gloria Estefan and Sheila E. Today Melanie continues to work in the Latin dance community teaching, performing, training, and choreographing nationally and internationally. She also works with many studios, students, and dancers in providing them the tools necessary to grow and improve.
